
Steps to access Standards from Open Polytechnic Library 2024

You need to go to Standards NZ via our library, so that you will be logged in with **Institutional Access**.

Step 1.

Go to the Open Polytechnic Library website: https:/mylibrary.openpolytechnic.ac.nz/

And click on **Databases**, from either the drop down under **Finding resources**, or the Databases tile:



Step 2.

Scroll to **Standards, Statistics & Reports**. Click on the heading to expand.


Step 3.

Click on **Standards New Zealand Online Library**. Read the Access instructions.

Standards New Zealand Online Library
Access is to NZS and joint AS/NZS standards. Read Section 3, Conditions of Use, of the Standards Service Agreement.


Step 4.

Login with your Open Polytechnic username and password.
This is the same username and password that you use to access iQualify.




Step 5.

You are now on the Standards New Zealand Online Library site.



Step 6.


To search for a Standard (NZ and NZS/AS joint Standards) type the Standard number into the search box. Examples of how to type the Standard number are NZS/AS 1158 (in Caps) or 1158.0:2005 or 1158. Press 'Enter'.



It's important to make sure that you use the **standard number** to search for the required document—keyword searches do not work!

Step 7.


Click on the **View PDF** button (not the name of the standard). This should download as a PDF to the bottom of your browser window.



Note! If you click the standard name it will take you to a page that requires payment.


Step 8.

The Standard will now download. Save the standard to a drive you use for your study, so it is easy to refer to as you work through your course.




Tip:
